

## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ADMISSION TO STUDY IN BACHELOR STUDY PROGRAMME PHOTOGRAPHY IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026 AND THE VERIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE

The standard duration of Bachelor's studies supported by the study plans is three years. The study program is completed with the Bachelor Final State Examination and the granting of the academic title "Bachelor of Arts" (BcA.).

Applicants who have completed secondary education or secondary vocational education and proved their competence to study and talent by succeeding in the admission procedure may be admitted to the Bachelor's study programs at FAMU. Only in absolutely exceptional cases justified by an application filed in advance may the Dean admit an applicant without full completed course of secondary or secondary vocational education; however, the applicant must graduate from secondary education prior to completing the Bachelor's study program.

The bachelor's degree study of Photography in English is intended for applicants interested in photography and visual arts who apply for the study in the last year of their secondary school studies or after having graduated from a secondary school. The study is structured in such a way that, in the first year, the applicants get acquainted with the basics of photographic representation, in the second year, they develop their knowledge in the field in specialized studios and in the photographic genres, in the third year they prepare for their bachelor's thesis. The study is based on the interconnection of practical and theoretical subjects.

Prerequisites for the study:

Interest, experience and knowledge of the contemporary context in the field of photography and motivation to study.

Completed secondary education, either before or during the beginning of their study at the Department of Photography.
